# CEE ADVISOR TO STEM EDUCATION CAUCUS



A STEM Education Caucus has been formed to provide a meaningful bipartisan forum for the 118th Congress to discuss issues related to science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM) education. The Center for Excellence in Education is serving as Advisor to the Caucus.

CEE Honorary Trustee Congressman Neal Dunn, M.D. (R-FL) and Congressman Jake Auchincloss (D-MA) formed the caucus to support and promote STEM education at all levels (K-12, higher education, and in the workforce). CEE will provide relevant education materials and experts to advance the goals of this important Congressional member organization.

CEE, founded by the late **Admiral H.G. Rickover** and **Joann DiGennaro**, has been a recognized leader in STEM education for 40 years, with programs to encourage leadership and innovation among top STEM students, to enhance STEM teacher professional development, and to expand the STEM career pipeline to underserved rural and urban students. The Center's 3,400 alumni represent all U.S. states. They are leaders in business and education, improving lives through research, innovation, and entrepreneurship.

### **REGENERON SCIENCE TALENT SEARCH WINNERS**

### **IN MEMORIAM**

The Center for Excellence in Education has lost a staunch supporter, a champion for CEE's educational programs, a friend to Admiral H.G. Rickover, and a mentor to Joann DiGennaro. For seventeen years, Senator Joseph Lieberman served as an Honorary Trustee to the Center, advising about educational policy, providing introductions for possible funding of the Center's work, and meeting with alumni of the Research Science Institute. The Center's first funding from the Department of Defense was made possible through meetings arranged by the Senator for the Admiral and Joann. The DoD funding sustained the initial Institute's ability to remain free of cost to academically talented high school students. The Institute has remained without cost to young high school scholars, many of whom could not have attended had the RSI had a fee. Senator Joe Lieberman and the Admiral were proud of their Jewish heritage, and spoke frequently about the importance of the need to prioritize science and technology studies to maintain U.S. global leadership.

The Center presents the Lieberman Award for Excellence in Science and Technology to an alumnus of its educational programs every two years. The recipient of the award is chosen by the Center's Board of Trustees. Senator Lieberman will be remembered for his love of country, family, and loyalty to friends. He was what Admiral Rickover once referred to as this nation's finest Mensch.

### **RESEARCH SCIENCE INSTITUTE**

# TEACHER ENRICHMENT PROGRAM



CEE's Research Science Institute (RSI) will be in session from June 23 to August 3, 2024, on the campus of MIT. RSI brings together 100 top U.S. and international high school students for the cost-free, six-week summer program that provides students with the opportunity to conduct original, innovative research. CEE Trustee **Mark Kantrowitz** (RSI '84) will serve as the Director of RSI. CEE's RSI combines on-campus course work in scientific theory with off-campus research in science and technology. Students learn at no cost from distinguished speakers from acadamia and the corporate world in evening presentations. Students present their research to a panel of judges. ### **USA BIOLYMPIAD**



Preparations are underway for the 2024 USA Biolympiad (USABO), the nation's most prestigious biology education and testing program for U.S. high school students. A record 682 schools registered for the exam, and nearly 10,000 high school students registered for the online Open Exam. The top 20 semifinalists will attend the USABO National Finals at Marymount University May 25-June 8. USABO. During the two-week USABO National Finals students participate in cost-free, intensive theoretical and practical biology tutorials. The four gold medalists from USABO's National Finals will represent the U.S. at the 35th International Biology Olympiad (IBO), involving student teams from over 70 countries. IBO will be hosted in Astana, Kazakhstan in July 2024. Every member of the U.S. Team has medaled in the international competition since the U.S. began competing in 2003. TEP is hosting virtual Bite of Science workshops and College & Career Panels for STEM teachers and principals at high schools. Recent topics have included aerodynamics, food science, cancer research, sports, information technology and computing, space, medicine, and architecture and design. All the TEP recordings are available for free on CEE's YouTube Channel. TEP organizes opportunities for underserved rural and urban high school teachers to take STEM information back to their classrooms. TEP links STEM educators across the country with professional resources and connections to advance their careers and to directly benefit their students. To date, more than 4,000 teachers from over 1,400 schools have participated, reaching more than 600,000 rural and urban students. **STEM LYCEUMS** 



Through its STEM Lyceums program, CEE sponsors cost-free webinars to connect underserved high school students with the Center's ecosystem of top STEM industry professionals and innovators. CEE's STEM Lyceums is a virtual club that builds high school STEM communities and engages students in discussions and explorations of STEM concepts and STEM career pathways, provided at no cost to students. Meetings foster critical thinking skills, encourage excitement for science, and prepare students to enter STEM careers. To date, topics have included aerospace, biomedical engineering, clean/renewable energy, data science, and cybersecurity genomics, health sciences, music, nuclear engineering, pharmaceuticals, smart devices in healthcare, and zoology.
