2021 Regeneron STS Scholars

CEE is pleased to announce that two Research Science Institute (RSI) alumni

are among the top 10 scholars in the Regeneron Science Talent Search 2021 science and math competition for high school seniors. **Yunseo Choi** (RSI '20), Phillips Exeter Academy, Exeter, NH, gamered first place and \$250,000 for her project where she played theoretical "match maker" for an infinite number of things or people. **Vivian Yee**, (RSI '20), International Academy, Bloomfield Hills, MI, was awarded ninth place. A total of 21 RSI alumni and a USABO alumnus were among the top 300 scholars. More...



CEE Programs Update

This summer, under the direction of Dr. Jamie Wells, MD, FAAP, (RSI '91), Research Science Institute will continue to bring together top U.S. and international high school students for the cost-free, six-week summer program that provides students with the opportunity to conduct original, cutting-edge research. Both RSI and the 2021 USABIOLYMPIAD (USABO) National Finals will be held virtually. In February thousands of students logged in to the first ever online USABO exam. Open Exam scores were released in March, and 408 students made the semifinalists cut off. Semifinals will be held virtually on April 16. CEE's Teacher Enrichment Program (TEP) is hosting virtual events this spring for rural and urban teachers in seven states, and the schedule is posted online. To date, nearly 1400 teachers from over 1,600 schools have participated. Teachers take TEP resources back to their classrooms. The program has reached more than 600,000 underserved rural and urban students to consider STEM careers.
