CEE Programs Update

Registration is open for CEE's 2024 Research Science Institute (RSI), which will bring together 100 top U.S. and international high school students for the cost-free, six-week summer program that provides students with the opportunity to conduct original, cutting-edge research. The Center's RSI is jointly sponsored with MIT. **Mark Kantrowitz** (RSI '84) will again serve as the Director of RSI. RSI continues to be cost-free for students to attend, thanks to the generosity of CEE donors. High school juniors or comparable may apply at https://www.cee.org/apply-rsi. The deadline is December 13, 2023.

Preparations are underway for the 2024 USA Biolympiad (USABO), the nation's most prestigious biology education and testing program for high school students. A record 682 schools have registered. For more information on USABO, visit https://www.usabo-trc.org.

CEE released the 2023 CEE Index of Excellence in STEM Education, that analyzes individual student rankings in each of five STEM-related Olympiad competitions; generates averages and rankings by participating country; and compares overall Olympiad performance by country. An analysis of Team USA's performance from 1993 to the present shows a steady improvement in average ranking, from approximately 6th to 2nd or 3rd place behind China in recent years. An increasing focus on STEM education in the United States is important to national success. In addition, increased competition in the global marketplace has driven students to distinguish themselves through excellence in academic competitions.

CEE's Teacher Enrichment Program (TEP) will host an in-person Northern Virginia teacher regional STEM workshop on February 24, 2024. TEP staff are excited to meet teachers in-person and to provide an environment for them to gain added resources for their classrooms. On October 26 TEP hosted "Taking a Bite out of Cancer," an online seminar featuring **Dr. Sharnise Mitchell**, Research Program Manager at St. Jude Children's Research Hospital. Watch on YouTube. On November 16 TEP hosted "What's in Your Food," a cost-free online seminar about STEM in food science featuring scientist **Dr. Maya Warren**. Watch on YouTube.

CEE's <u>STEM Lyceums</u> is a monthly virtual club for underserved high school students to learn about STEM professions and career pathways, provided at no cost to schools or students. On November 15 CEE hosted "Science in Music," an online seminar featuring **Dr. Mark Temple**, a Senior Lecturer in Molecular Biology from the School of Science at Western Sydney University.
