CEE Programs Update

CEE's 2021 Research Science Institute (RSI) will be held virtually June 27-August 7 in collaboration with Massachusetts Institute of Technology. RSI brings together top U.S. and international high school students for the cost-free, sixweek summer program that provides students with the opportunity to conduct original, cutting-edge research. CEE's Teacher Enrichment Program (TEP) is hosting virtual events for rural and urban teachers in seven states. TEP has provided cost-free resources to teachers in 12 states to access and use in the classroom. To date, nearly 4,000 teachers from over 1,600 schools have participated, reaching more than 600,000 underserved urban and rural

students. CEE's 19th annual <u>USA Biolympiad</u> was a tremendous success. This year nearly 9,000 students from 464 schools, 42 states, and 8 International Schools registered for the nationwide competition. A recording of the closing ceremony featuring Nobel Laureate **Robert J. Lefkowitz**, MD, Professor of Medicine, James B. Duke Distinguished Professor of Medicine, Professor of Biochemistry, Professor of Pathology, Professor of Chemistry, Duke University, is posted on <u>YouTube</u> along with a <u>playlist</u> of other impressive speakers.



CEE Welcomes Todd Young as Honorary Trustee


